No.JNIM-202/22/2024-HS-HEALTH: In supersession of previous existing Schemes issued in this regard, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to make the following schemes for allotment of postgraduate seats in medical colleges / institutes under the Government of Manipur.

1. **Short title and commencement.**
 - (i) These Schemes may be called “The Manipur Medical Postgraduate Seat Allotment Schemes, 2025”.
 - (ii) These Schemes shall come into force from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Definitions.** In these schemes, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - (i) “Director” means the Director of Medical Education, Manipur.
 - (ii) “Government” means the Government of Manipur.
 - (iii) “Scheduled Tribes” means the Scheduled Tribes specified by the Competent Authority of the respective State Government.
 - (iv) “Scheduled Castes” means the Scheduled Castes specified by the Competent Authority of the respective State Government.
 - (v) “Other Backward Classes” means the Backward Classes specified by the Competent Authority of the respective State Government.
 - (vi) “Seat” means a seat in MD / MS / Diploma courses in a medical college / institute under the Government of Manipur.
 - (vii) “Qualifying Examination” means NEET-PG or any equivalent examination which, in scope and standard, is equivalent to NEET-PG and as decided by the Competent Authority from time to time.
3. For the purpose of these schemes, there shall be the following Committees:
 - (a) State Level Medical PG Selection Committee consisting of the following:
 - (i) Administrative Secretary (Health), Government of Manipur. –Chairman.
 - (ii) Director of Medical Education, Manipur. –Member Secretary.

- (iii) Director of Medical Colleges/ Institutes concerned --Member
 - (iv) An Officer not below the rank of Deputy Secretary nominated by Government of Manipur. --Member
- (b) State Level Medical PG Counselling Committee, as authorised by the State Level Medical PG Selection Committee, consisting of the following:
- (i) Dean (Academics) of the respective Colleges/ Institutes --Member
 - (ii) An Officer not below the rank of Deputy Director as nominated by the Director, Medical Education --Member
 - (iii) An Officer not below the rank of Deputy Director as nominated by the Director, Health Services -- Member
 - (iv) Any other Officer as deemed necessary by the Selection Committee --Member

One of the Dean shall be the nominated as Convenor by the Selection Committee from time to time.

4. **Distribution of seats.**

50% of the seats in every medical college / institute shall be reserved for the All India Quota (AIQ). Remaining 50% of the seats in every medical college / institute shall be reserved for the State Quota (SQ).

- (a) Provided that 50% of the seats in each department /subject in a medical college /institute shall be reserved for AIQ and the remaining 50% of the seats in each department /subject in a medical college /institute shall be reserved for SQ.
- (b) Provided that if the total number of seats in a department /subject is an odd number, the seats shall be divided between AIQ and SQ with the extra seat alternating between the AIQ and SQ on an annual basis.
- (c) Provided that the 40% of the SQ seats shall be reserved for Direct category.
- (d) Provided that 10% of the SQ category seats shall be reserved for Institutional Preference (IP) category and be allotted to candidates who passed/ graduated from the concerned medical college / institutes.
- (e) Provided that 50% seats of the SQ seats shall be reserved for In-service category and be allotted to In-service candidates sponsored by Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Manipur.

5. **Eligibility and Qualification.**

In order to be eligible for the open counselling for SQ seats, the following conditions shall be fulfilled:

- a. Candidate must be NEET-PG or equivalent examination qualified for the academic year.
- b. To be eligible for Institutional Preference category, candidates must have completed MBBS from the concerned medical college / institutes.
- c. To be eligible for In-service category, candidates must be in regular service under Health & Family Welfare Department, Government and must possess Sponsorship certificates from the concerned Competent Authority.

6. Qualifying Examination.

Qualifying examination for both the seat categories, 50% AIQ and 50% SQ, shall be NEET-PG or any equivalent examination which, in scope and standard, is equivalent to NEET-PG and as decided by the Competent Authority from time to time.

7. Reservation of Seats.

Government shall reserve seats for Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Castes, Other Backward Classes (non-creamy layer) as notified by the Government from time to time, in all the seats belonging to the SQ categories - Direct, Institutional Preference & In-service categories.

- (a) Provided that a Model Roster of 200 points for direct recruitment shall be adopted for reservation of seats in each of the departments arranged in alphabetical order of the name of the departments in the respective colleges / institutes (as shown in the **Appendix**)

Explanation: 'Rolling basis' above shall mean that reservation of seats for the current academic year will be in continuation from the roster point immediately below the last roster point utilized in the previous academic year.

- (b) Provided that the colleges / institutes shall be arranged in order of year of establishment for the roster point allocations. The college / institute established earlier shall be placed above the college / institute established later.

8. Allotment of Seats.

(i) All India Quota (AIQ): 50% AIQ seats in every medical college / institute shall be allotted to candidates by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India or any other organisation as decided by the Competent Authority from time to time.

(ii) State Quota (SQ): 50% SQ seats in every medical college / institute shall be allotted to candidates by open counselling conducted by the State Level Medical PG Selection Committee under the Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Manipur or any other Committee as decided by the Competent Authority from time to time.

(a) Provided that merit lists of the eligible applicants will be prepared for all the SQ categories - Direct, Institutional Preference & In-service categories in order of their All India Ranks (AIR) in the NEET-PG or equivalent examination of the academic year.

(b). Provided that allotment of seats shall be done strictly on merit basis. Candidate higher in rank in the merit list shall be given the chance to select his/her seat choice earlier than the candidate lower in rank.

(c). Provided that if a seat belonging to any SQ category remains vacant / unfilled due to lack of eligible candidates in the merit list, the said vacancy / unfilled seat shall be carried forward to further rounds of counselling till it is filled by any newly eligible candidates.

(d). Provided that if a seat belonging to any SQ category remains vacant / unfilled till the last round of counselling due to lack of eligible candidates in the merit list, the said

unfilled seat shall be treated as an unreserved seat in the respective SQ category and filled as per proviso (b) given above in the last round itself.

9. **Power to remove difficulties.**

If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of these Schemes, the Government may take such remedial measures not inconsistent with the provisions of these schemes as may be necessary or expedient for removing such difficulty.
