No. CELL-1011/14/2026-RD and PR-RD&PR : In exercise of the power conferred under section 6 of the Viksit Bharat –Guarantee for Rozgar and Ajeevika Mission (Gramin) Act, 2025, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to notify the peak Agricultural seasons of sowing and harvesting as below:

I. For Valley Districts

Sl No.	Agricultural Season	Period	No. of Days
1.	Kharif (Sowing)	15 th July to 8 th August	25 Days
2.	Kharif (Harvesting) & Rabi (Sowing)	15 th November to 9 th December	25 Days
3.	Rabi (Harvesting)	5 th March to 14 th March	10 Days
Total			60 Days

II. For Hill Districts

Sl No.	Agricultural Season	Period	No. of Days
1.	Kharif (Sowing)	15 th June to 14 th July	30 Days
2.	Kharif (Harvesting) & Rabi (Sowing)	15 th December to 13 th January	30 Days
Total			60 Days

2. The Peak Agricultural Season has been identified in consultation with the Department of Agriculture, Manipur keeping in view of the distinct agricultural practices and cropping patterns prevailing in the Valley and Hill areas of the state of Manipur.

3. During the above-mentioned periods, the concerned Deputy Commissioners/District Programme Coordinators (VB-G RAM G) shall ensure that no work are taken up during the above period as per the provision of the VB-G RAM G Act, 2025 and shall also make necessary arrangements for incorporating the above Peak Agricultural seasons in the annual planning and implementation of VB-G RAM G in their respective districts.

4. This notification shall take effect from the date of issue and shall remain in force until further notification.
